



Public Works & Utilities Advisory Committee Minutes

Monday, August 8, 2016- 6:00 pm

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1. **CALL TO ORDER; ROLL CALL:** Keith Sowinski called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.
Keith Sowinski, Ed Kazik, Dave Baranczyk, Don Dahlstrom, Dan Deruyter, Richard Happel, David Smith. Were present. Excused Tim Carpenter.
2. **VERIFY/MODIFY/APPROVE MEETING AGENDA:** Motion made by Ed Kazik, second by Dave Smith to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
3. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** July 11, 2016. Motion made by Don Dahlstrom, second by Richard Happel. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **COMMITTEE BUSINESS:**
Discussion and Committee recommendations re:
 - A. Road Repair Options Associated with Water Loop project: The discussion focused on the amount of road repair that is already needed on the roads within the loop project. At this time 60% of N. Overland Rd. from Sunlite to Trout Creek is in need of repair due to deterioration. Don Dahlstrom stated that the plan selected needs to include pedestrian travel because more and more people are walking and biking in the area. We also want to connect the subdivisions to the Four Seasons Park eventually. The widening of the road may be 15 to 20 years out at this point. Motion made by Don Dahlstrom, second by Ed Kazik, to recommend that the road be pulverized and repaved. The motion passed unanimously.
 - B. Speed limits on Trout Creek Road (east of Overland): There will be a plat review for a new subdivision going in off of Trout Creek Rd. for Planning & Zoning. There was discussion of the intersection safety when headed down the hill. Discussion was to reduce the speed limit to 35 mph and place Blind Intersection or Hidden entrance signs to alert drivers to the new road. Motion made by Ed Kazik, second by Dave Baranczyk to reduce the speed limit to 35 mph on Trout Creek from N. Overland to County J; the full length of the study area. The motion passed unanimously.
 - C. Other items brought forth by Committee members or staff: There were no items brought forward for discussion.
5. **MEETING ADJOURNMENT:** Motion made by Ed Kazik, second by Don Dahlstrom, to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:30pm.
